

ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR

NOTIFICATION

Dated Dispur, the 20th. Jan /1983

The Government of Assam in the Political Department have created a post of Director of Vigilance and Anti - Corruption Assam to strengthen and ensure effective functioning of the Vigilance and Anti-Corruption machinery of the State. The Governor of Assam is pleased to order that the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Assam will discharge the following duties and functions under the overall control, direction, supervision and guidance of the Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Assam who is presently functioning also as the State Vigilance Commissioner and that the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption will have jurisdiction and powers in respect of matters to which the executive powers of the State extend.

2. The Governor is pleased to order that the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Assam will perform the duties and functions in respect of (A) Vigilance and (B) Anti-Corruption work as indicated below .

(A) Vigilance Work

(i) On specific direction from the State Vigilance Commissioner, he will enquire into and investigate .

(a) any complaint that, a public servant had exercised or refrains from exercising his powers for .dishonest and corrupt purposes.

(b) any complaint of corruption, misconduct, lack of integrity or indulgence in malpractices or misdemeanour on the part of public servants includ-

ing members of the All India Services in connection with the affairs of the State Government.

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(ii) In consultation with and on the direction of the State Vigilance Commissioner, he may submit proposals regarding vigilance matters to the Chief Secretary, Assam for consideration of the Government.

(B) Anti-Corruption Work

(i)(a) Where cases are registered and investigated by the Anti-Corruption Branch, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption will inform the Commissioner and Secretary, Political Department, Assam the result of such investigation. If he is of the view that a prosecution should be launched and sanction for prosecution is required to be issued in the name of the Governor he will forward the full report of the investigation to the Chief Secretary, Assam for processing further action by the Political Department.

(b) If any authority other than the Governor is competent to sanction prosecution, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Assam with the approval of the Secretary, Political Department, Assam will forward to such authority the investigation report for sanction for prosecution.

If such authority does not propose to accord sanction sought for by the Anti-Corruption Branch the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Assam will forward the case together with his views and other relevant records to the Chief Secretary, Assam for further advice through the Political Department of the Government.

(ii) On the direction of the Chief Secretary, Assam or Secretary, Political Department, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Assam will make an enquiry into the cases referred to him by the various Administrative Departments. He will furnish the report of the enquiry together with other relevant records to the Chief Secretary, Assam or the

Secretary, Political Department as the case may be for further action.

3. The Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption will formulate proposals whenever considered necessary for prevention and control of corruption and submit such proposals to the Chief Secretary for consideration of Government in the Political Department.

4. The Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption may advise Government, through the Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam regarding changes in procedure and practices with a view to eliminating changes of corruption and about methods / procedures for redress of public grievances.

5. The State Government will prescribe the reports and returns to be submitted by the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption.

6. The above duties and functions are only illustrative and not exhaustive. The Government may include or modify any of the sanctions entrusted to the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption in this notification.

The Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption will be under the Administrative control of the Political Department. The existing staff in the Anti-Corruption Branch will stand transferred to the Directorate. The officers and staff of the Anti-Corruption Branch will continue to draw their pay and allowances from the existing Head of Account.
