**Advertisement for Recruitment to 1 (one) post of Director of
Prosecution and 3 (three) posts of Deputy Director of
Prosecution, in the Directorate of Prosecution, Assam.**

Dated 11th July, 2023

In pursuance of the Assam Directorate of Prosecution Establishment Officers' Service Orders, 2022, issued vide Notification No. HMA-11/225/2022/63 dated 17/02/2023; applications are invited from the eligible candidates for recruitment to 1 (one) temporary post of Director of Prosecution and 3 (three) temporary posts of Deputy Director of Prosecution, in the Directorate of Prosecution, Assam. The interested eligible candidates shall have to submit their respective application in the Form appended herewith along with all necessary documents as mentioned below to the **Secretary to the Government of Assam, Home & Political Department, Block-C, 1st Floor, Janata Bhawan, Dispur, Guwahati-6**, by Speed Post/ Registered Post/ by Hand between 11:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on all working days, clearly mentioning on the envelope the post he/ she has applied for and such application, complete in all aspects, should reach the office of the undersigned on or before 11/08/2023 positively. Applications received after that date shall not be opened and shall not be considered for recruitment.

1	Name and Number of the posts	Director of Prosecution: 1 (one) Post. Deputy Director of Prosecution: 3 (three) Posts.
2	Age as on 01-03-2023 :	For the post of Director of Prosecution: Not less than 45 (forty five) years of age and not exceeding 60 years of age. For the post of Deputy Director of Prosecution: Not less than 40 (forty) years of age and not exceeding 60 years of age.

3	Reservation of posts :	The posts advertised are for Open Category.
4	Scale of Pay :	Pay scale of Judicial Officers + Other allowances, as admissible under Government Rules, revised from time to time. Director of Prosecution : Rs. 1,99,100/- - Rs. 2,24,100/- Deputy Director of Prosecution: Rs. 1,63,030/- - Rs. 2,19,090/-.
5	Tenure of Service :	For both category of posts : a period of 3 (three) years or attainment of the age of 60 (sixty) years, whichever is earlier, except on disciplinary grounds or on the ground of criminal offences.
6	Educational qualification :	For both category of posts: Bachelor's Degree in Law from a recognised University of India (established or incorporated by or under a Central Act or Provincial Act) or an Institute recognised by the Government of Assam or University Grants Commission (UGC).
7	Service qualification :	For the post of Director of Prosecution: Having practice as an Advocate for a period not less than 10 (ten) years. For the posts of Deputy Director of Prosecution: Having practice as an Advocate for a period not less than 10 (ten) years.
8	Eligibility criteria :	(i) The candidate must be a citizen of India. (ii) The candidate must possess character that is suitable in all respects for employment in Government Service.

		<p>#Persons dismissed from any service by the Union Government or any State Government or any local Authority or by any Corporation or body held or controlled by the Union of India or any State Government shall not be eligible for appointment to any post in the service.</p> <p>#Persons convicted of any offence of moral turpitude shall not be eligible for appointment.</p> <p>#No person who has more than one wife, living or in case of a woman is married to person already having a wife living shall be eligible for appointment to any post in the service.</p>
9	Application fee :	Will be intimated later.
10	How to apply :	<p>The eligible candidates shall have to apply by Registered Post/ Speed Post/ by Hand, submitting the Form appended herewith, complete in all aspects, enclosing all necessary documents, to the Secretary to the Government of Assam, Home & Political Department, Block-C, 1st Floor, Janata Bhawan, Dispur, Guwahati-6 clearly indicating in the envelope- “APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF DIRECTOR OF PROSECUTION” or “APPLICATION FOR THE POSTS OF DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF PROSECUTION”, whichever is applicable.</p>
11	Documents to be submitted :	Duly filled up application form, affixing a self attested Photograph on the top rightside of the Form, along with self attested

		<p>photocopies of the following documents/certificates:</p> <p>(i) Matriculation/ 10th Standard/ HSLC Admit Card/ Pass Certificate issued by Central/ State Board, having clear indication of the Date of Birth.</p> <p>(ii) Pass Certificates and Mark sheets of all examinations from Matriculation/ 10th Standard/ HSLC onwards up to the level of qualifying examination.</p> <p>(iii) Document showing Date of Enrolment, with a self declaration that after enrolment he/she has not left practice as Advocate and has not joined any other service/ profession/ business. In case contrary facts to such claim, comes to fore subsequently, his/ her candidature shall be rejected and may even lead to termination from service, if detected after joining service.</p> <p>(iv) 2 (two) Passport size photographs.</p>
12	Selection Criteria :	<p>Direct recruitment to the posts of Director of Prosecution and Deputy Director of Prosecution shall be made by a Selection Committee by adopting the summery recruitment process through verification of documents and Personal Interview.</p> <p>After the verification of documents the Selection Committee shall call such numbers of candidates for personal interview, as many can reach the level, prescribed by the Committee.</p> <p>The total marks for Personal Interview will be</p>

50 marks. While granting marks in the Personal Interview the Committee shall, inter-alia, also take note of the number of years practiced as Advocate, number of cases appeared before the Court, number of cases reported against his/ her name, etc. The percentage of marks awarded to each candidate at the Personal Interview shall be added to the percentage of marks obtained by him/ her in the qualifying examination (LL.B.). On the basis of the average of both, the Committee shall prepare a list of the candidates in order of merit.

If two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the average, the name of the candidate obtaining higher marks in the qualifying examination (LL.B.) shall be placed higher in the list and if both such candidates have obtained same marks in the qualifying examination (LL.B.) then, the one senior in age will be higher in position.

For the post of Director of Prosecution, the Selection Committee shall forward a panel of 3 (three) names in order of preference, from the merit list so prepared, to the appointing authority. The appointing authority will select one name from the panel of 3 (three) names and send the name so selected for the concurrence of the Hon'ble Chief Justice, Gauhati High Court.

For the posts of Deputy Director of Prosecution, the Selection Committee shall forward as many names as the number of vacancies notified in this advertisement, to the appointing authority.

13	Date, Time and Venue of Personal Interview:	Will be announced and intimated in due course of time.
14	Physical and Medical Standards:	The candidates should be in good health-mentally and physically and he shall be free from any physical disabilities due to which there is a possibility of hindrance to performing his duty efficiently. Persons with speech, hearing and sight impairedness are not eligible for appointment to the posts of Director of Prosecution and Deputy Director of Prosecution. Any candidate before being finally approved for the recruitment will be expected to pass the Medical Board Examination.
